We are overjoyed to share a special update from our monthly Ladies' Meeting, which celebrated its 2nd anniversary in May! This small but vibrant group of young ladies and mothers gathers every last Saturday of the month to equip and encourage one another in our shared journey of serving the Lord. Over the past two years, we have seen incredible growth, both spiritually and in our community bonds. We are excited for what the future holds and look forward to continuing this journey of growth and service.



With hearts full of gratitude and joy, we are thrilled to share a recent victory in our mission to win more souls for Christ. Our dedication and eagerness to spread the Gospel have borne incredible fruit as we shared the Good News with ten teenagers, and by God's grace, they all accepted Christ as their Savior! This remarkable moment has strengthened our resolve and fueled our passion to continue reaching out to those who have yet to hear the Gospel. We are committed to nurturing these new believers through regular Bible studies and discipleship, ensuring they grow strong in their faith. We ask for your continued prayers for our visitation efforts and the prospects for our Bible studies. Pray that God will open hearts and doors, allowing us to bring more souls into His Kingdom.

We humbly ask for your continued prayers for our outreach efforts in Kampong Ous village. For over a year now, we have been dedicated to discipling the adults and teaching the children, witnessing their growth and positive response to the Word of God. We pray that these new believers will find the courage to boldly proclaim their faith, declaring Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Many face fear of disownment, criticism, and persecution from their families and communities, making it difficult for them to openly profess their faith. Your prayers are vital in supporting these brave souls as they navigate these challenges.



We earnestly seek your prayers for our main church, particularly for our English class ministry, which serves as an extension of our soul-winning and feeding initiatives. Recently, one of our young participants had to stop her studies with us due to other school-related activities, but we are blessed to report that she continues to attend church faithfully.



This young believer has faced challenges at home, as her mother wants her to stop attending church and focus on other activities like tutorials. Despite this pressure, she has stood firm in her faith, telling her mother she no longer needs those tutorials and choosing to continue her commitment to church. Praise the Lord for her steadfastness! Please pray for her strength and perseverance, and for her mother's heart to be softened. Your prayers are crucial in supporting her and others facing similar trials.

We kindly ask for your continued prayers for our family. From early February until May, we endured scorching weather (heat index was 120°F) that challenged us in many ways. Our car's compressor broke, leaving us without air conditioning during this intense heat. Despite this, we remained steadfast in our commitment to outreach, visiting, and soul-winning. Our car and tricycle are vital for these ministries, and we continue to pray for a more reliable and larger vehicle to better serve our church needs. We are now experiencing rain this time; it's an earlier start to the rainy season than usual. Thank you for standing with us in faith and prayer.

I would like to take this opportunity to ask for your prayers for my dad's church building project in one of his village outreaches. Pastor Isagani Antonio Sr. has been a dedicated missionary here for 24 years and just turned 81 last May. Despite his age, his passion for preaching the Word of God and participating in church activities remains undiminished. Pastor Isagani oversees a main church and several outreaches. Due to budget constraints and the rising cost of construction materials, we have taken on the role of laborers to continue the construction of the church building ourselves. We ask for your prayers for God's provision and guidance in this project. If you want to be part of investing in this project, any amount is a great help and much appreciated.
