Dear Beloved Pastor, Church and Loving Friends,

Greetings in the Mighty Precious Name of our only Saviour, Jesus Christ!

Thank you to all your prayers and love, I arrived safely in the Philippines last December 25th, exactly on Christmas day; all the struggles from a long-haul flight (18hrs) were eased when I saw the sweetest smiles and warm hugs from my wife (Gladys) and my only begotten son (Abram).

I really do appreciate you all, especially, you, Pastor, who encouraged and inspired me.

To do God's work may not be easy, but it is such an honor and a GREAT privilege to work for The KING OF KINGS and The LORD OF LORDS!

My four (4) months deputation in the U.S. is not a walk in the park, but rather, it is all God's Grace, Mercy and His Faithfulness that is renewed every morning, and such a huge blessing that you sir, and the church have become part of my journey in praying for partners in the missions here in Davao Region, Mindanao, Philippines.

I have visited one hundred twenty-seven (127) churches in twenty one (21) states, drove more than ten thousand miles (10,000 miles), driven three (3) cars for four (4) months, one car gave up when I was on my way to Sugar Grove, North Carolina, thanks to my dear friend Buddy Cornett and to his family who assisted me that day, and to all who without any hesitation showed their love, concern and readiness to help at that time of my need, I love you all and really appreciate it from the bottom of my heart.

It took me two (2) weeks to recover by adapting again the Philippine climate, from jet lag and climatizing coming from a four (4) season country, going back again to a tropical climate that is hot and hottest. Two (2) weeks after rest, our mission team is already gearing up in preparation for an important and much awaited mission work.

1. Street Preaching and Gospel Tract Distribution,
2. House to House Evangelism and Discipleship,
3. Kids Feeding Program (2pcs of Fried Chicken, Rice and Lollipop)

We greatly thank the Lord for His faithfulness, in giving you, Pastor, church and our beloved friends as our partners in the ministry here in Mindanao, Philippines. Your continued prayers and support have allowed us to carry on the mission work with amazing results through God's grace.

We are always enthusiastic to work and share how God's hands of blessing are continually felt and evident in the work of the ministry in this side of the planet, and these all are possible because of our unified effort and love for lost souls to know our Saviour Jesus Christ; there are still very remote communities here in our area that have no access in power and clean water, more of the Powerful message of salvation through Jesus Christ.

As God's command and directive, this mission work is our united cohesive mission that God placed in our hearts, and these all are in everything as our responsibility and to glorify our great God who have blessed us so much, and in return we give our service in any ways; thank you for helping us in spreading God's love to every people, especially to the children in our mission area, the kids do love you all and your love to them is very much appreciated; you are always in all of our prayers.

Much work to be done and to accomplish, there are twenty (20) local missionaries and church workers who in hand in hand helped us a lot to move forward and progress in soul winning and coaching these indigenous believers in training as our next generation of Christ's soldiers in the prospect areas to plant more churches in the years to come.



By God's grace, we have eight (8) mission churches already, and we are praying that in the next 10 years, God will help us to plant twenty (20) more churches; in these eight (8) missions churches, we have two-hundred fifty (250) families, and four hundred (400) children enrolled in our feeding program.

In the next two (2) months, GLORY TO GOD! We will be opening our ninth (9) mission church; in preparation, we are soliciting used clothing, hygiene kits, school supplies, vitamins, used shoes, flip flops, canned goods, solar lights, diapers for babies, milk for both babies and malnourished kids.



These goods to be distributed in this community where we will be opening another mission church, is a way of saying thank you that these indigenous tribe and their leaders have allowed the Gospel of salvation through Jesus Christ in their hearts and permitted us to plant a local tribe mission church in their area.

These indigenous tribes need Jesus and need physical aid as well, although they owned a vast area of land, but they do not possess technical know-how and necessary tools to make their lands productive; this is where we come in hand in hand, to help and guide them, not just spiritual things, as well as livelihood programs.


In the years to come, we openly invite you Pastor, and everybody whom God placed in your hearts to not just help and support our mission program but also want to experience to help in our mission field, especially for these indigenous people; those with medical background, education, carpentry and farming as well, are very most welcome.

In closing, please help us with prayers and support for there is still much to be done in sustaining this mission work that all of us are involved, our mission prayer request are as follows.

1. 50 churches or individuals to support our mission work for \$50 a month,
2. \$1,000 for two (2) outdoor sound systems (Public Preaching & Film Showing)
3. Generator set (3,000 watt capacity), laptop & Projector (Film Showing)
4. \$172,000 to repurchase our church lot and building from the bank, we have raised \$2,600 already.
