There was this instance that we had to wait for them to come back from school to start our Prayer Meeting, for their school has been holding them out even after 5pm for their roles in their school's newspaper.

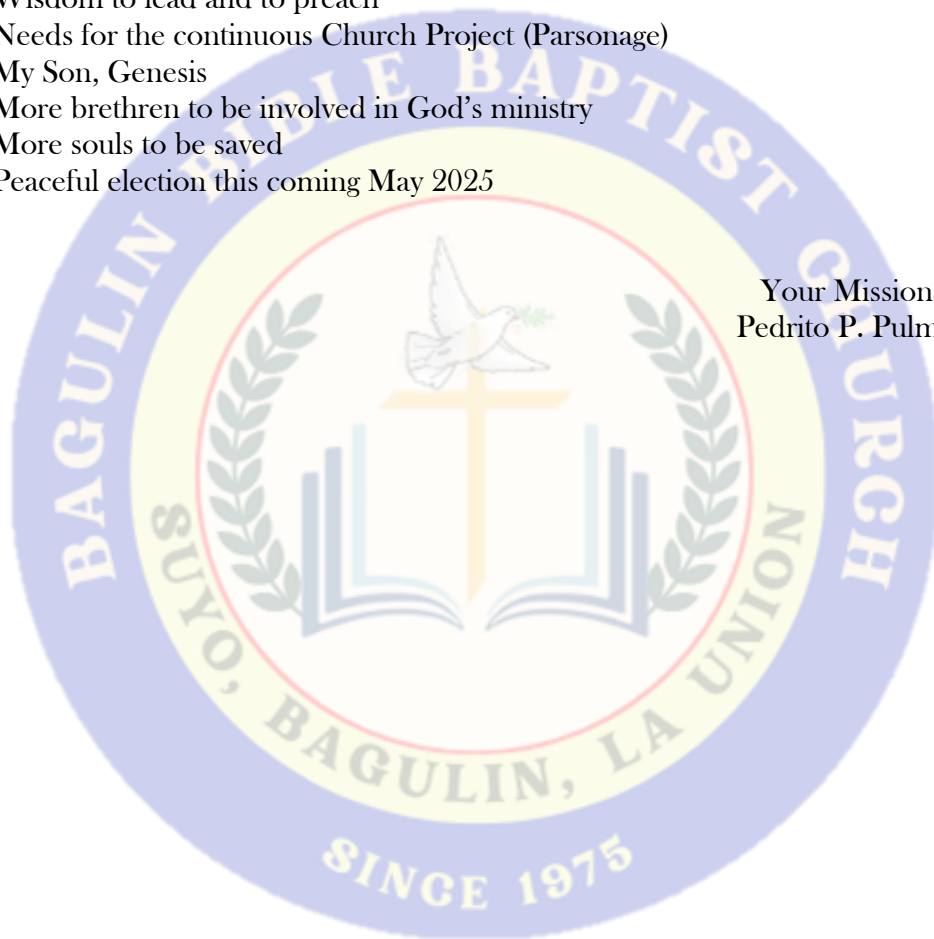
